


### A SHAFT... OR RATHER A CHASM...


YOU DISCOVER THIS REMARKABLE NATURAL CAVITY WITH A DIAMETER OF 33 METRES AND A DEPTH OF 75 METRES...

- Visits begin with a *103-metre descent underground* by lift or stairs, followed by a walk through the caves to the pier, where you set off for a boat ride.
- The river takes you past the *Grande Pendeloque* ("Great Chandelier"), an impressive 60-metre-long stalactite that hangs over the *Lac de la Phuie* ("Rain Lake").
- Disembarking from the boat, you continue to the *Lac des Gours* ("Dam Lake") and the incredible *Salle du Grand Dôme* ("Hall of the Great Dome") whose cathedral-like ceiling rises to a height of 94 metres, revealing a multitude of geological wonders shaped by nature over millions of years.











Édouard-Alfred Martel, equipped with heavy rope ladders and candles, first enters the caves, known among local people as "The Devil's Hole".

After almost 10 years of *major works*, the Gouffre de Padirac welcomed *its first visitors*.

The Gouffre de Padirac is visited by *3 935 people* over the whole year.



*Electricity* is brought to the cave system's galleries. This really is a *technical* and acrobatic feat!

# THE HISTORY OF THE GOUFFRE DE PADIRAC: A FEW DATES

ON 9 JULY 1889, ÉDOUARD-ALFRED MARTEL ENTERED ONE OF THE MOST MYSTERIOUS CHASMS EVER EXPLORED, AND QUICKLY SET ABOUT MAKING IT POSSIBLE FOR THE PUBLIC TO VISIT HIS DISCOVERY. TO HELP FUND THE PROJECT, HE TEAMED UP WITH GEORGE BEAMISH, A DESCENDANT OF THE IRISH BREWING FAMILY OF THE SAME NAME, AND AFTER MANY MONTHS OF WORK THE FIRST VISITORS DESCENDED INTO THE GOUFFRE DE PADIRAC ON 1 NOVEMBER 1898.

480,000 visitors IN 2005, LÆTITIA DE MÉNIBUS-GRAVIER, GEORGE BEAMISH'S GREAT-GREAT-GRANDAUGHTER TOOK OVER MANAGEMENT OF THE COMPANY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE GOUFFRE DE PADIRAC, AND UNDERTOOK TO LAUNCH A NEW CHAPTER IN ITS HISTORY WITH AN ENERGETIC PROGRAMME TO RESTORE THE IMAGE AND APPEAL OF THE GOUFFRE DE PADIRAC.

Visitor facilities have been redesigned under her impetus to create a better visitor experience.

The operating company now provides visitors, whether residents or tourists, with a *cultural and artistic programme* including photo exhibitions, recitals and events. *Access to everything for everyone* remains a strong commitment for France's foremost underground natural heritage site. This is demonstrated by *support for charities* through specific initiatives, by greater scientific and cultural accessibility with *school visits* and by *providing educational tools*. Scanned archive material is also available to all via the Padiracothèque.

As part of this objective to *highlight the cultural value of this natural underground monument*, Lætitia de Ménibus-Gravier recently initiated a structural and landscaping project to improve the reception facilities for *the Gouffre de Padirac, which will celebrate the 130th anniversary of its discovery in 2019*.

HISTORIC HERITAGE


Civilization goes back thousands of years in this region: traces still remain of the first humans, including magnificent examples of *cave art* and *prehistoric drawings*. Over the centuries, an *exceptional heritage* has accumulated: castles, churches, buildings, medieval villages etc.

Six of the *most beautiful villages in France* are located on the banks of the river - Autoire, Carennac, Loubressac, Turenne, Collonges-la-Rouge and Curemonte - near the Gouffre de Padirac, the holy city of Rocamadour and the Causses du Quercy Regional Nature Park.

The Dordogne Valley is known for its *superb cuisine*: gourmet experiences are a *way of life* here, thanks to the region's dedicated farmers, producers and chefs; on market days, the villages present a lively, colourful spectacle.... 




YRICALARTS, AZZ, THEATRE...

During the morning, tour the *Gouffre de Padirac* and embark for a boat ride 103 metres underground.

Nested in the heart of *Causses de Quercy Regional Natural Park*, in the arid Rocamadour landscape, the Rocher des Aigles lies in a wild landscape and offers an invitation to travel.




